Thank you for your interest in doing something so crucial as writing to assist in residents making safer and wiser decisions in resident-contractor relations. Writing speaks volumes we can continually refer to. It is the most versatile voice on earth.



Volunteer writing is suggested to remain focused on general resident-contractor relations in the U.S.

Specific emphasis is on *documented* home maintenance and improvement events only. It is suggested that volunteer writers convey most recent episodes (preferably within last 30 days) thematic to and consistent with advocating and supporting dissemination of data helpful to senior residents arriving at safer decisions hiring building trades personnel.

In light of HGRBS objectives for sharing free information with residents, private individuals with great writing skills are asked to keep within the theme of the nonprofit. No fee. No accolades. Just plain passion for being able to express ourselves in this way, as well.

Subsequently, it is recommended that volunteer writings include general:

- a. Tips about doing or avoiding certain things in order to get the best possible results from contractors.
- b. Special emphasis on contractor-related home maintenance and improvement.
- c. Related information for residents arriving at better choices for contractors and getting better results from the same.
- d. Offering links to various (non-monetary) sources and safe websites (including those of HGRBS).
- e. Presenting other information from which those concerned can benefit enormously in resident-contractor relations.
