Writing is the root medium for communicating information which does not dissipate like audio-visual alternative means. It is the most versatile and enduring “voice” on earth. Writing speaks volumes we can continually refer to.

In light HGRBS objectives for sharing free information with our residents, the nature of writing expected is hoped to be and remain focused on events (negative or positive) in relation to how contractors are doing or have done work on your property or on that of senior residents with respect to home maintenance and improvement priorities. It is suggested that you write about episodes which are thematic to and consistent with advocating for and supporting the rights and privileges of our senior private home decision makers in the United States, exclusively.

Subsequently, it is recommended that your writings include:

- a. Tips about doing or avoiding certain things in order to get the best possible results from contractors.
- b. Special emphasis on contractor-related and home maintenance and improvement.
- c. Related information for residents arriving at better choices for contractors and getting better results from the same.
- d. Offering links to various (non-monetary) sources and safe websites (including those of HGRBS).
- e. Presenting other information from which residents concerned can benefit enormously in relation to their private home maintenance and improvement projects.
